Litchfield's charm also derives from our status as a Connecticut hidden gem, in part because many of our favorite things can seem a bit hidden; close by and popular, but also special and private.

This guide is intended to highlight those hidden gems and the town's wealth of other attributes for those who want to explore and discover, or stay for a weekend, a week ... or forever.



Marquee Events

Litchfield Hills Road Race

Established in 1977, the Litchfield Hills Road Race is a great Litchfield tradition that attracts elite runners from around the world. It's held the second Sunday in June, and in years not affected by extenuating circumstances, it includes children's races and other festivities that make road race weekend an exciting time for visitors and spectators to be in Litchfield.

Litchfield Makers Market

The Litchfield Makers Market is a new addition to road race weekend. Artists, photographers, ceramicists, sculptors, printmakers, wineries, distilleries, bakers, chocolatiers, coffee roasters, local farms, floral artists, antiques, designers, and more exhibit on the Green for the public to enjoy.

Springtime Splendor

Every spring, the magnificent fields of daffodils at Laurel Ridge (presented for public enjoyment by the Morosani family along Wigwam Road) and abundant hiking trails draw hundreds, even thousands, of outdoor admirers. Litchfield's extremely popular Restaurant Week also takes place in March — with dozens of participating restaurants presenting delicious special menus for all to enjoy.

Summer Events & Concerts on the Green

Every summer the Park & Recreation department sponsors a series of Wednesday evening concerts on the Green, featuring a wide range of popular regional bands and business showcases (including special deals on grab-and-go concert dinners). Also taking place each July is Litchfield's "Top Dog" summer hot dog contest involving several competing local restaurants. Plus, you don't want to miss Litchfield Community Center's annual SummerFest Gala — a fun-filled celebration of community.

Fourth of July

Litchfield has a terrific Independence Day fireworks display at Litchfield High School. The Litchfield Historical Society offers a Heroes of the Revolution Walking Tour, as well as the popular July 4th Pet Parade and Turn-of-the-Century Fest. The First Litchfield Artillery fires its cannon 13 times at the All Wars Memorial in Bantam to pay tribute to the original 13 colonies.

Fall Activities


Autumn is a breathtaking time of year in Litchfield. The Litchfield Land Trust hosts its fall Sunset Party — an annual benefit to support its efforts to preserve and protect strategic forest and farm land. The Litchfield Community Center hosts a Harvest Bounty Brewfest with live bands, great food, lawn games, and fire pits. And before Halloween, the Litchfield Historical Society hosts a terrific 'Scarecrows in the Meadow' display in the Tapping Reeve Meadow.

Family Nature Day at White Memorial

Family Nature Day each September is a highlight of a calendar packed with great outdoor and nature-oriented activities at the White Memorial Conservation Center, the heart of the larger White Memorial Foundation with 4,000 acres of preserved land and 40 miles of trails.

Holiday Festivities

Litchfield's Holiday Stroll & Tree Lighting — coordinated by the Park & Recreation department — features carolers, ornaments at the Litchfield Historical Society, hay rides courtesy of Bunnell Farm, the lighting of the holiday tree on the Green, and more. The Oliver Wolcott Library's Festival of Trees gala, together with its fabulous Week of Wonder holiday auction, features a magical celebration, unique items from local merchants, and more.
